### **Discussion Questions:**

- Is there anything you learned in this passage that seemed new to you?
- How does this passage better inform your understanding of who God is?
- How do the truths revealed about God in these passages help shape the way believers should live in light of the Gospel? Explain.
- As Christians, how can we connect the truths we've learned from this section of God's Word and faithfully communicate them to a non-believer? What key points would you focus on, and how would you guide them toward the Gospel?
- Mill Creek, how can this text guide our church community and foster a positive impact on our local body? Considering our whole church, What does an appropriate response look like in reference to the Scripture and sermon?

### **Application Questions:**

- Have you ever felt singled out — in a good way — when someone remembered you by name during a hard time? How does it feel to know that Jesus personally knows your name and your failures, yet still calls you back to Him? What does this say about the personal nature of His forgiveness?
- Can you think of a time when God took something painful or sinful in your life (or in someone else's) and turned it into something good? What would it look like this week to believe that your past regrets don't have the final word — that Jesus' resurrection power can still redeem them?
