Discussion Questions:

- Is there anything you learned in this passage that seemed new to you?
- How does this passage better inform your understanding of who God is?
- How do the truths revealed about God in these passages help shape the way believers should live in light of the Gospel? Explain.
- As Christians, how can we connect the truths we've learned from this section of God's Word and faithfully communicate them to a non-believer? What key points would you focus on, and how would you guide them toward the Gospel?
- Mill Creek, how can this text guide our church community and foster a positive impact on our local body? Considering our whole church, What does an appropriate response look like in reference to the Scripture and sermon?

Application Questions:

- Sometimes we ask spiritual questions not because we want truth, but to argue, trap, or avoid real commitment. Have you ever done this (even subtly)? What would it look like for you to bring honest questions to Jesus instead?
- If we believe Jesus is the rejected-but-exalted cornerstone, how should that change how we live this week? How can we help both "insincere" and "genuine" people around us ask the right question about Jesus?
