Discussion Questions:

- Is there anything you learned in this passage that seemed new to you?
- How does this passage better inform your understanding of who God is?
- How do the truths revealed about God in these passages help shape the way believers should live in light of the Gospel? Explain.
- As Christians, how can we connect the truths we've learned from this section of God's Word and faithfully communicate them to a non-believer? What key points would you focus on, and how would you guide them toward the Gospel?
- Mill Creek, how can this text guide our church community and foster a positive impact on our local body? Considering our whole church, What does an appropriate response look like in reference to the Scripture and sermon?

Application Questions:

- In 1 Corinthians 12:12, Paul says the church is like one body with many different parts. Why do you think some Christians feel like their part doesn't matter? How does this passage encourage us to value every person's role in the church, even if their gifts look very different from ours?
- How should the truth that we are God's adopted sons and daughters change the way we view God, treat other people in the church, and face difficult times?
