Discussion Questions:

- Is there anything you learned in this passage that seemed new to you?
- How does this passage better inform your understanding of who God is?
- How do the truths revealed about God in these passages help shape the way believers should live in light of the Gospel? Explain.
- As Christians, how can we connect the truths we've learned from this section of God's Word and faithfully communicate them to a non-believer? What key points would you focus on, and how would you guide them toward the Gospel?
- Mill Creek, how can this text guide our church community and foster a positive impact on our local body? Considering our whole church, What does an appropriate response look like in reference to the Scripture and sermon?

Application Questions:

- We are ALL worshiping something—we're pouring ourselves out for what we love. What are some common things people in our culture (or even in our church) tend to worship instead of Jesus?
- Pastor Jeremy asked: "Why are extreme responses at an NFL game allowed, while extreme responses in Christian worship feel weird?" How do you feel about that tension? What holds us back from more expressive worship at Mill Creek?
