Discussion Questions:

- Is there anything you learned in this passage that seemed new to you?
- How does this passage better inform your understanding of who God is?
- How do the truths revealed about God in these passages help shape the way believers should live in light of the Gospel? Explain.
- As Christians, how can we connect the truths we've learned from this section of God's Word and faithfully communicate them to a non-believer? What key points would you focus on, and how would you guide them toward the Gospel?
- Mill Creek, how can this text guide our church community and foster a positive impact on our local body? Considering our whole church, What does an appropriate response look like in reference to the Scripture and sermon?

Application Questions:

- Mark 14 is not mainly about heroic discipleship but about human failure and Jesus' unwavering faithfulness. Why is it important that we see our own failures clearly before we can truly understand the gospel?
- "Stop trusting your strength. Trust the faithful Savior." What is one practical way this week you can shift from trusting in yourself to trusting more fully in Jesus' faithfulness?
