Discussion Questions:

- Is there anything you learned in this passage that seemed new to you?
- How does this passage better inform your understanding of who God is?
- How do the truths revealed about God in these passages help shape the way believers should live in light of the Gospel? Explain.
- As Christians, how can we connect the truths we've learned from this section of God's Word and faithfully communicate them to a non-believer? What key points would you focus on, and how would you guide them toward the Gospel?
- Mill Creek, how can this text guide our church community and foster a positive impact on our local body? Considering our whole church, what does an appropriate response look like in reference to the Scripture and sermon?

Application Questions:

- Are there parts of Christianity that you find difficult to explain or that might seem foolish to your friends? How can you remain confident in what God has revealed?
- How might our culture today consider the message of Jesus "foolish" or outdated?
- Who is someone in your life, that if they became a Christian, you would only be able to attribute their salvation to the work of the Spirit? What Bible verses would be good to pray for this person?
