Reach Up

Prayer Highlight: Praise God for a wonderful Easter Service, celebrating the resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ!

Worship Ministry

- Pray for additional volunteers to serve in our ministry, specifically choir members as we seek to grow our team.
- Pray for Pastor Brian as he continues to work on his project and seeks to complete his
 doctoral studies at Southeastern that he will continue to make progress on his final project.
- o Pray that we would continue to grow in our abilities as musicians and singers.
