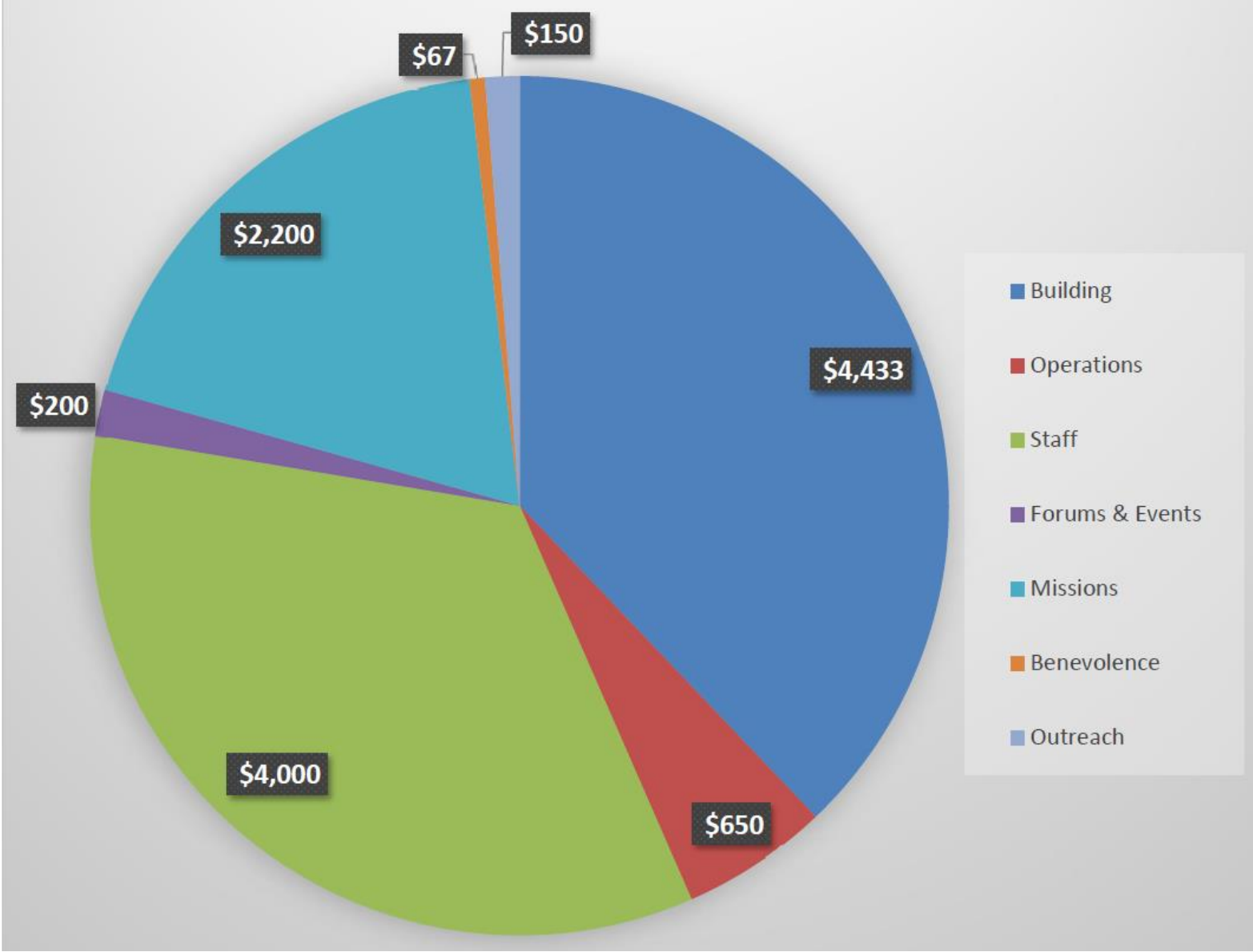

1 Timothy 5:17-18

The **elders who rule well** are to be considered **worthy of double honor**, especially those **who work hard at preaching and teaching**. For the Scripture says, “You shall **not muzzle the ox** while he is threshing,” and “The laborer is **worthy of his wages**.”

Galatians 6:6-7

The **one who is taught** the word is **to share all good things with the one who teaches *him***. Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for **whatever a man sows, this he will also reap**.

1 Peter 5:1-3

Therefore, I exhort the elders among you, as your fellow elder and witness of the sufferings of Christ, and a partaker also of the glory that is to be revealed, shepherd the flock of God among you, exercising oversight not under compulsion, but voluntarily, according to the will of God; and **not for sordid gain**, but with eagerness; nor yet as lording it over those allotted to your charge, but **proving to be examples to the flock**.

2 Corinthians 9:6-8

Now this I say, **he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly**, and **he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully**. Each one must do just as he has **purposed in his heart**, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for **God loves a cheerful giver**. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed.

1 Corinthians 9:8-14

It is written in the Law of Moses, “You shall **not muzzle the ox** while he is threshing.” God is not concerned about oxen, is He? Or is He speaking altogether for our sake? Yes, for our sake it was written, because **the plowman ought to plow in hope, and the thresher to thresh in hope** of sharing the crops. **If we sowed spiritual things in you, is it too much if we reap material things from you?** If others share the right over you, do we not more? Nevertheless, we did not use this right, but **we endure all things so that we will cause no hindrance to the gospel of Christ.** Do you not know that those who perform sacred services eat the food of the temple, and those who attend regularly to the altar have their share from the altar? So also **the Lord directed those who proclaim the gospel to get their living from the gospel.**

Conclusion

- Pray for God to add more “kingdom focused” believers to the body
- Look into the capacity of your personal budget for increased giving
 - Remember, we reap what we sow!
- The elders have spent countless hours laboring for the body
- Paying leadership is God's design for the church so that the elders are best enabled do what they're called to do
