## Here is a simple Bible reading method to help get you started.

1. **PRAY** Start with a brief prayer asking God's Spirit to help you to delight in His Word, understand His Word, believe His Word, and obey His Word.
  
2. **READ**
  - a. You may want to try various methods of reading to see which one works best for you (silently, out loud, listening to an audio version, hand copying, etc).
  - b. You might want to get a good study Bible to read. The NIV Biblical Theology Study Bible and ESV Study Bible are great.
  
3. **UNDERSTAND**
  - a. **Context**
    - i. Is there anything about the historical context that helps me understand this passage? Who wrote it? Who was it written to? Where does this fit in the story of the Bible? A study Bible helps with these questions.
    - ii. Is there anything about the immediate context (before or after) that helps me understand this passage?
  - b. **Observation**
    - i. Is there anything I don't understand? What questions do I have?
    - ii. What stands out to me?
    - iii. What does this teach me about God?
    - iv. What does this teach me about humanity or myself?
    - v. What does this teach me about the gospel of Jesus Christ?
  - c. **Meaning:** Try to summarize this passage in a sentence or two. What's the main point?
  
4. **APPLY**
  - a. What are some general principles from this passage?
  - b. Is there something to worship or thank God for?
  - c. Is there a promise for me to claim or a truth for me to believe?
  - d. Is there something I am convicted about that I need to change or begin doing?
  - e. Is there something or someone I need to pray for specifically this week?
  - f. How does this passage "send" me into the world? Who can I talk to about what I'm reading?
  
5. **PRAY** Thank God for what you've read and ask him to help you to live it out today.
