

NORTH BIBLE CHURCH MAN WEEKEND DETAILS, MAP & SCHEDULE

DATES/TIMES: August 8-10. You can arrive at the campgrounds any time after 1pm.

Burgers/dogs are provided at 6pm and our first session is at 7pm. Please check-in when you arrive in the dining hall. If you arrive after 7pm we will be up the hill in the rec center. If you would like food saved for you let Wes know. Food is also available in Payson.

LOCATION: Mountain Meadows Ranch is located in Christopher Creek AZ. 630 Mountain Meadows Dr, Payson, AZ 85541. MMR is a 70-acre ranch about 90 miles from Scottsdale. The elevation is about 6000 feet and the temperature in late August ranges from a high of 85 and an overnight low of 55.

DIRECTIONS: Take Highway 87 (Beeline Highway) to Payson. Take Route 260 East approximately 20 miles to the Christopher Creek turn off and take a left. In about a mile take a left on the dirt road just past the Creekside Steakhouse. Follow the MMR signs about a mile to the MMR camp and park at the end of the road in the parking area by the dining hall.

LODGING: We will be staying in cabins with bunk beds and there is a building with bunkbeds, power, heaters, bathrooms and showers. If you want to sleep in your vehicle, tent, camper etc, please connect with Wes regarding the logistics.

ACTIVITIES: Frisbee golf, ping pong, poker, fire pits, spike ball, football, beersbee and napping ☺. **Fishing** – Christopher Creek flows through the property so you are welcome to bring a fishing rod and you will need a valid fishing license. **Archery** – Bring your own targets, bows and arrows if interested in target shooting at camp. **Hiking** - Lots of great trails so bring your hiking shoes/boots.

Meet Dr. CHARLIE KUTHE!

Let me begin with a bit about my personal story. I grew up in a non-Christian home, but came to faith at the age of 16 through my participation in a local church youth camp. My initial career plan was to become a pediatrician, but as I grew in my faith during my college years it became clear that God had other plans. It was during this time, and through my participation and discipleship in a campus ministry, that I developed a love for the local church. My wife, Erin, and I met during our time at the University of Arizona and were married in April 1999. This past year we celebrated 25 years of marriage and are so grateful to the Lord for the life and ministry together that He has provided! We have two beautiful daughters: Naomi, age 20, and Hannah, age 18. I have served as the Senior Pastor of Park Springs Bible Church in the Dallas/Fort Worth area since March of 2015. We just celebrated 10 years of ministry here this past spring!

Prior to moving to Texas, I was the Senior Pastor of Georgia Plain Baptist Church in Georgia, Vermont for 11 years. During our time in Vermont I also enjoyed my volunteer service with the Georgia Fire and Rescue Department as a fireman, EMT and also their chaplain. I received my Bachelor's Degree from the University of Arizona in General Biology and my Master of Divinity degree from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary. Upon completion of my MDiv, my wife and I were given the opportunity through the Parish Pulpit Award to move to Edinburgh, Scotland, where I obtained a Master of Theology in the area of Christian Ethics and Practical Theology. Later, In 2017, I received my Doctor of Ministry degree from Denver Seminary with a thesis focused on preaching.

I currently serve on the board of directors for Reach All Nations International, a ministry focused on teaching and training indigenous pastors in India. I have also been involved as a chaplain for the Arlington Police Department during our time at Park Springs Bible Church. Just this past year I was given a Holder of Hope Award for my leadership and service to others in the city of Arlington, Texas.

I have a deep desire to come alongside those who are hurting with the life-transforming power of the Gospel, and for the church to be a home for the hurting. Biblical counseling is something that has been a part of my ministry from the beginning, as I count it an honor to be a part of what the Lord is doing in the lives of others. Thus, developing a vibrant soul care ministry within our church has been a great joy for me to see happen. My wife and I are both certified biblical counselors and are passionately committed to communicating the Gospel both to those who are lost, and to those who are hurting.

For fun I love spending time with my family and I love adventure and the outdoors. I enjoy hunting, fishing, backpacking, camping and basically anything outside or thrill related. I have run 5 marathons and I completed my 1st Ironman in 2022. I have plans for more and hope to complete a 100-mile trail race by the time I turn 50 (which is next year).

The verse that frames the ministry God has called me to is 2 Timothy 2:10, "Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory."
