Young Driver Permission (version 11)

As part of the ministry to Peace youth, sometimes it is convenient for a youth to be in a vehicle driven by an approved driver that is 18 years old or older, but under 21. The Peace Child Protection Policy requires drivers to be approved in addition to being 21 or older, although parental permission must be granted in writing if they allow their youth to be driven by a driver as young as 18. While acknowledging the greater risk posed by younger drivers, by signing below you authorize your youth to be driven by an approved driver that may be as young as 18. This form is only valid for a maximum of 1 year and expires on August 31st following the date the parent signs it. It may be revoked at any time by notifying "team@peacepca.org". Limited approvals may be given as noted below.
