6. How does our society train us to determine whether or not something we are doing is purposeless? Where are you tempted to believe that your "labor is in vain"? What do you tend to do when you doubt whether your labor has any purpose?
7. How can we determine if our labor is genuinely "in the Lord"? Asked another way, "How would we know if our labor was not "in the Lord"?"
