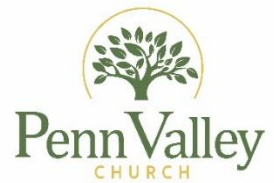

Expected Ministry Duties:

- Lead sound biblical and theological teaching (weekly at youth group and young adults)

- Develop short and long-term plans for the ministries
