**Cross Plains Baptist Church**

*(First home of the future Piedmont First Baptist Church) (1870)*

*"Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom" from St. Luke 12:21 was the first sermon given by Elder Sterling Gresham Jenkins to eleven charter members who founded, constituted and organized on Saturday, January 8, 1870 a church known as Cross Plains Baptist Church. The "Little Flock" worshipped in the Cross Plains Academy from 1870 to 1878.*
