From the pages of the "Little Flock"

Wednesday, January 6, 1948 Church Conference brought the unveiling of the Building Committee's preliminary plans: a "T" shaped building with a 600 seat spacious sanctuary made of brick to be constructed first on the North Main Street property (north of the former Piedmont High School) purchased for \$1.00 from Mr. and Mrs. J.O. Bennett. After much consideration it was recommended by the Building Committee in the regular conference, Wednesday, June 8, 1949 and special conference on Wednesday June 29, 1949 that in compliance with the request of the First Baptist Church in Conference in October 1948 that:

- 1. The First Baptist Church of Piedmont begin its sanctuary building immediately on the location of the 1926 pastorium next to the 1905 church.
- 2. We build by the unit plan. This plan is to build one unit at a time in order to prevent incurring a heavy indebtedness. This of course would necessitate building on the present site
