From the pages of the "Little Flock"

Rev. Henry Augusta Williams, a missionary Baptist Church builder, lead in the building of a small wood framed one room white-clad board first house of worship for the growing "Little Flock" on Dailey Street in Piedmont in 1878. The following letter appeared in the Alabama Baptist Newspaper on Thursday, June 27, 1878: Now brethren, in behalf of the few good sisters and the cause of Jesus Christ at this place, I ask you to help me build a Baptist house of worship here. Considering the population, there is not a more important location for a Baptist meeting house in my whole district than this. We want a house 25X40 feet, neatly finished.
