From the pages of the "Little Flock"

A dream came true for the "Little Flock" on Opening Day Sunday, August 20, 1950, when they went into their new sanctuary (Psalms 100) for a dedication service with guest speakers Dr. S.J. Ezell of Howard College, for the morning service, and the Rev. R.E. Hood, former pastor, for the evening service. Rev. Hood had the first vision for the new sanctuary eight years earlier! After the morning service, the first wedding in the auditorium of the new building was held on the hot summer afternoon (no air conditioning!) of Sunday, August 20, 1950 when Miss Helen McCord (sister of Mr. Hugh McCord and Mr. Forrest Dobbins were Married by Pastor, R. E. Longshore.
