From the pages of the "Little Flock"

On Sunday, August 3, 1958 the "Little Flock" in special conference licensed Bro. Troy L. Morrison to preach. Bro. Morrison attended Southern Baptist Theological Seminary and received his B.D., M. Div., and D. Min. degrees (1962). Bro. Morrison's ministry would lead him to serve with the Alabama **Baptist State Convention as** director of church-minister relations and cluster coordinator of the departments of Deacon Family Ministry, Annuity and Insurance, and Church Administration. In September 1990, Dr. Troy Morrison took office as Executive Secretary of the State Board of Missions and Treasurer of the Alabama Baptist State Convention and held until his retirement on January 31, 1999.
