Holland Thomas placed much emphasis on good teaching, soul winning, and visitation. On one such meeting, past -pastor Rev. Ralph Longshore, who was with the Sunday School Board of the Southern Baptist Convention, Nashville urged the setting of worthwhile goals and good organization of the Sunday School Departments to promote growth. The fruits of their labor was an all-time "High Attendance Day" of 548 in Sunday School set in 1954. A truly remarkable feat that has not been matched!
