From the pages of the "Little Flock"

Through the visionary efforts of Rev. Bob Calvert, the First Baptist of Piedmont began and refined from 1972 to 1985 a Preschool Education Program that would aid in the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual development of approximately 35 children plus parents each year. This ministry and outreach of the "Little Flock" continues today! Realizing the need not only for a Preschool Children's Program, Bro. Bob Calvert discussed at the Sunday, July 2, 1978 Deacon meeting the possibility of starting a Senior Adult Program. The Deacons and church approved a \$500 budget addition for the remainder of the church year to financially support the Senior Adult Program which would come to be known as the Sunshine Club, which continues today! A very spiritfilled ordination service was held at West Park Heights Baptist Church prior to Bro. Ray Lloyd's departure as their Minister of Music/Youth to begin his ministry to the "Little Flock" on Wednesday, January 9, 1991. The deacons of the "Little Flock" joined their brothers in Christ at West Park Heights to constitute an ordination council on Sunday afternoon prior to the charge and ordination of Bro. Ray Lloyd as a Minister to the Gospel on Sunday evening, December 30, 1990. After settling in to the church home in Little's Subdivision, Bro. Ray as Minister of Music and Youth earnestly began his ministry. Bro Ray recognized his gifts of having a vision for the Lord's work and of preparing the "Little Flock" spiritually through music. A very special and memorable event in the life of the "Little Flock" occurred on Sunday, April 24, 1983 when Brothers Jimmy Haines, Kevin Dobbs, Marty Lively, and Bill Wilks were ordained as ministers of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.. As a youth in the "Little Flock", John Gunter grew up

spiritually under the guidance of Bro. Bob Calvert, Bro. Paul Harbison, and Bro. Jimmy Haines. A 1982 graduate of Piedmont High School, John would further his education with a B.S. degree in building construction from Auburn University (1987) and a Master of Divinity degree from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary (December, 1995). John would marry Dana A. Deloney,

an Auburn University graduate of Education, on August 6, 1988. They have two sons: Daniel Clark and Luke Hamilton. Commissioned by the International Mission Board on February 11, 1997, the Gunters would begin language school in preparation to serve as church developers in the Dominican Republic starting in 1999. The "Little Flock" is humbled and blessed to claim Bro. John Gunter as one of its own. In 1998, the "Little Flock" approved a yearly love offering of one percent of its annual non-designated tithes for the Gunter's missionary work. (Matthew 28:18-20)
