### *From the Pages of the "Little Flock"*

*A unique feature of the early Baptist Church was the once-a-month Saturday afternoon church conference. All who were conference members would work until "dinner time." About one o'clock in the afternoon, all who were concerned assembled at the church and the business of the church was discussed and action was taken on all necessary matters. Other matters could be brought before the conference concerning any church member who was not living by the church doctrine with removal from the church a possible order. Any member missing a single Sabbath service would stand before the congregation on the next Sabbath to give an account of his where-about. Any member missing two Sabbath services required a committee visit by two elder men or deacons of the church to ascertain the reason of the absence and report to the congregation their findings. Any member missing three Sabbaths required the pastor and men to approach the member about their absence and to justify a possible recommendation to the church conference for expulsion (Exodus 20:9-10 and Hebrews 10:25) The first known person to be 'excluded' from fellowship at Cross Plains was in 1880. Only through repentance and a period of good behavior could the person be 'restored' into the fellowship.*
