Celebration of one hundred years in

the life of the "Little Flock" of Piedmont First Baptist (1870-1970) included the following activities: Wednesday night, October 21, 1970, the WMU and Brotherhood presented an excellent program at the midweek service. Sunday, October 25, the congregation observed "New Homes Day." Wednesday night, October 28, Bro. Gordon Wooddy presented a brief account of the Training Union movement and its local history. Sunday night, October 25, former pastor, J. Holland Thomas, was the guest for the evening worship hour. November 1, a special service was held to honor those in Christian vocations. Thanksgiving Day, Thursday November 26, 1970 was Homecoming Day for the "Little Flock"! The "Centennial Hymn" was written by Tom Hill, music and youth director. The "Little Flock" of 1970 would draw wisdom from the lessons of the past 100 years so that they might Successfully meet the crisis of that day and the challenge of their tomorrow.
