From the Pages of the "Little Flock"

The Baptist congregation sold its "Little White Church in the Pines" on Dailey Street to the Coosa Manufacturing Company in late 1904 for \$500 after petitioning the Probate Court of Calhoun County for permission to sell since there was not a clear deed and title on the land donated by Mr. Jacob Kibler Daily. The Coosa Manufacturing Company enlarged the old church building to establish the Coosa Grammar School which was used until the Southside Elementary School was completed in 1961. Later the building was used as a net manufacturing plant until the City of Piedmont renovated to create the Piedmont Senior Citizen Center and Municipal Court Complex. Fire completely destroyed the building on Sunday morning, November 8, 1992 (Ecclesiastes 3:1-6) In 1999, the site was prepared for the Chief Ladiga Rails-To-Trails Eubanks Home Rest Stop and Information Center. Interestingly enough when one rides or walks on the Rails-To-Trails it is the same railroad track pathway surveyed by Rev. George Dent in the late 1880's.
