Christmas Assistance is for Children age newborn thru 13 yrs. old

1. Parent's/Guardian's picture ID verifying their date of birth. (Example: an AL Driver License or Passport)
2. Applicant's and each household member's Social Security card. (This means children's cards, as well, from newborn to 13 yrs. old.)
3. Proof of current full address if it is different from identification. (Example: a power bill or official mail from a government office)
4. Proof of your total monthly income. (Example: check stubs, a letter stating amount of unemployment, a letter stating amount of child support, a letter stating amount of food stamps, etc. (The letters must be from the correct agencies.)
5. Verification of Non-income. (Example: One letter from one of the following agencies will be sufficient. [DHR, Housing Authority, Food Stamps, Unemployment, or Social Security].)

The above information is for those who need this assistance and did not sign up with the Benevolence Christmas Star, Salvation Army or any other Christmas Assistance for their children. Their deadline is Dec. 4th. Please pass this info on to those you think may need it. Thank you!
