CONTEND FOR THE FAITH THE EPISTLE OF JUDE

Part One

I. INTRODUCTION

Jude, the brother of James and the half-brother of Jesus, writes this brief but powerful epistle encouraging the recipients to “contend for the faith.” False teachers had invaded the early church. False teachers and their teachings are still a problem today.

Contend means to wrestle with. As believers we will continuously contend.
