The Coronation of Christ Matthew 21:1-11

I. Introduction

- A. The Harmony of the Gospels
 - 1. All four account for Triumphal Entry
- B. The Prophecies Fulfilled That Day
 - 1. The past prophecy of Zechariah 9:9
 - 2. The future prophecy of Revelation 7:9

II. Body

- A. The Coronation Claim (vv. 1-7)
 - 1. The normal entry into Jerusalem at Passover
 - a. A state of humility. The traveler dismounts their donkey and reverently walks into the gate.
 - b. Jesus rides in boldly fulfilling the prophecy of Zechariah.
- B. The Coronation Carpet (v.8)
 - 1. An ancient tradition (2Kings 9:13)
- C. The Coronation Cry
 - 1. "Hosanna" "Save Now" (Ps. 118:25)
 - 2. "Blessed is He" (Ps. 118:26)
 - 3. "Son of David"
 - a. The crowd acknowledges Christ's Messianic claims.
- D. The Coronation Critics (vv. 10-11)
 - 1. Luke 19:39-40

III. Conclusion

- A. God's long awaited Messiah had finally come.
