Sermon Noles

The Wedding at Cana John 2: 1-11

"When Jesus sees a heart that can't wait, He can't wait either. At the wedding at Cana, Jesus may have done nothing if it wasn't for Mary's faith. How many situations are we in right now that God won't act without our faith?"

"Jesus did many other things as well. If every one of them were written down, I suppose that even the whole world would not have room for the books that would be written. John, the Beloved; **John 21:25**

Jesus turning water into wine was the first of 7 "signs" in the Gospel of John. A sign is a miracle that points beyond itself to a major truth about God, made known by Jesus Christ.

(1) Jesus joins a wedding feast. (vv. 1-2)

- Possibly less than a week after His baptism.
- The significance of Jesus attending a wedding ceremony at the beginning of His ministry.
- (2) A request, a question, and a statement. (vv. 3-4)
- A grand occasion on the verge of a great embarrassment.
- Mary's request: "They have no wine."
- Jesus' Question: "Woman, what does this have to do with me?"
- Jesus' Statement: "My hour has not yet come."
- (3) The empty jars are made whole. (vv. 5-8)
- A lesson on obedience.
- Our obedience is to be entire.
- Our obedience is to be exclusive.
- Our obedience is to be **specific.**
- (4) Jesus' ministry is a ministry of conversion. (water to wine, sinners to saints) (vv. 9-11)
- A thirsty crowd.
- Empty waterpots.
- Filled w/water.
- Water to wine.
