THE TOWER OF BABEL GENESIS 11:1-9

PREFLOOD UTOPIA

- Lengthy life spans because of closeness to genetic perfection of Adam and Eve.
- Greenhouse environment with a water canopy filtered out harmful uv rays
- Freer communication between God and man.
- Arts and industry begin to flourish. (Genesis 4:20-22)

POST FLOOD RESTRAINTS

- Duration of life and length of generation.
- Soil takes more toil and gives less yield.
- Animals are now more a part of diet. Animals have greater fear of man.
- Pluralizing languages is the greatest restraint.

MAN ATTEMPTS TO RIVAL GOD (vv.1-4)

- People of the land share one language
- The move eastward.
- “And let us make a name for ourselves.”
- God’s command was: “And you, be fruitful and multiply, increase greatly on the earth and multiply in it.” (Gen. 9:7)
- The rebellious people refused to “be dispersed over the face of the whole earth.”

GOD ATTEMPTS TO SAVE MAN (vv. 5-9)

- The Lord came down.
- The Lord initiates a counterplan.
- *“The focus of Genesis has been both on God’s plan to bless mankind by providing that which is “good” and on man’s failure to trust God and enjoy the good God has provided.”* J. Silow Baxter
- Genesis 12: 1-2 brings God’s plans into clear focus.
