SERMON ON THE MOUNT 3
MATTHEW 5-7
THE BEATITUDES
MATTHEW 5:5

“If you think meekness is weakness, try being meek for a week.” David Egner

SOTM OVERVIEW

One pitfall that we must be careful not to tumble into while reading the SOTM is to see Jesus' words from a gospel of works framework. We naturally tend to understand the world in terms of merit, self reliance, and achievement. The gospel of works says that if I will discipline myself and do what I ought to do then all will go well with me, God will approve of me, and I will go to heaven one day. This is a false gospel. It isn't the gospel of Jesus.

BEATITUDES OVERVIEW

“The Beatitudes are not the gospel because they do not explicitly explain Christ's atoning death and resurrection and how one may receive Him. But they are preparatory to the gospel. The Beatitudes are preparatory in the sense that they slay us so that we may live. They hold us up against God's standard for the kingdom so that we can see our need and fly to Him. They cut through the delusions of formula Christianity and expose the shallowness of evangelicals who give all the “right” answers but do not know Christ.”

THE BLESSING

“Blessed are the meek...”

Example of Nicodemus.

John 3:1-8; John 19:38-42

THE PROMISE

“.....for they shall inherit the earth.”

Psalm 149:4. *“The meek will he beautify with salvation.”* The meek are the only ones who inherit the earth. The **“they”** in “they shall inherit” is emphatic: “They alone, only they, shall inherit the earth.” They are rich right now; and fifty billion trillion years into eternity they will be lavishing in the unfolding of “the incomparable riches of his grace” R. Kent Hughes
