#### **SOTM OVERVIEW**

#### **BEATITUDES OVERVIEW**

Dr. Sinclair Ferguson's book *The Sermon on the Mount* reminds us that Christians are not free to embody only some of the traits in the Beatitudes (pp. 35-36). As believers, we must possess all the qualities of Matthew 5:2-12, at least in some measure, lest our claim to have faith be proven false.

## THE BLESSING

"Blessed are the pure in heart..."

The Pharisees lived by the maxim: "Blessed are the outwardly clean, for they shall see God."

In **Matthew 23:25-28** Jesus pronounces judgment on the Pharisees for their hypocrisy.

**Kathoros-** physical, religious, and moral cleanness or purity in such senses as clean, free from stains or shame, and free from adulteration

Psalm 24:3-4; Psalm 51:10

A better interpretation "They shall be continually seeing God for themselves."
