## Youth Fund Raiser

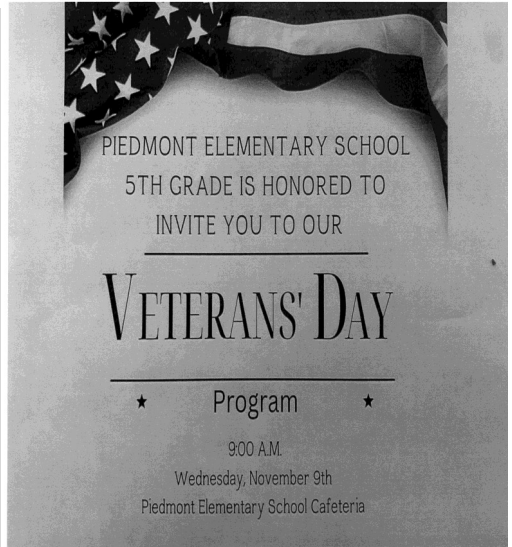
The youth will be having a Spaghetti lunch on November 5th right after church. You may eat in or get a to go plate. The cost will be \$5.00 per plate donation.
