AT THE CROSS WE SEE SALVATIONS STORY LUKE 23:39-43

TWO MEN CONDEMNED

- Fulfillment of prophecy. (**Isaiah 53:12**)
- What their punishment tells us about them.
- What their punishment reminds us of about ourselves.

TWO DIFFERENT CONCLUSIONS

- They reach two different conclusions about who the man in the middle is.
- They reach different conclusions regarding their guilt.
- The two men reached different conclusions about what they wanted to be delivered.
