



A Borrowed Tomb

Isaiah 53:9

I. Introduction

A. Christ has died by crucifixion.

- 1. The need to bury him before the Sabbath**
- 2. A secret disciple asks for the body of Christ**
- 3. The prophecy fulfilled by Joseph of Arimathea.**

II. Body

A. The Solemn Burial (Matthew 27: 57-60)

- 1. The family tomb of Joseph.**

B. The Sealing of the Tomb (Matthew 27:62-66)

- 1. The stone represents the despair of death.**
- 2. The stone is sealed by the enemies of Jesus.**
- 3. The stone is meant to separate Jesus from his disciples.**

- 1. The resurrection declares Christ is the Son of God. (Romans 1:4)**
