SERMON NOTE April 28, 2024 Living Above the Chaos

Titus Sermon Series Impacting the Chaos Titus 3:1-8

I. Introduction

- A. Paul gives Titus three areas of responsibility for every local church.
 - 1. The church is to be an orderly church.
 - 2. The church should emphasize the teaching of sound doctrine.
 - 3. The church should be ready for every good work.

II. Body

- A. Our obligation to those outside the church. (vv. 1-2)
 - 1. Follow the rule of authority unless it will cause disobedience to the Word of God. (Romans 13:1)
 - 2. We are to show all manner of good to all sorts of people. (Romans 12:18)
- B. Our gospel transformation. (vv. 3-7)
 - 1. Every life is characterized by sin before salvation. (Romans 5:10-11)
 - 2. Our lives are changed because of the regeneration and and renewal of the Holy Spirit.
 - 3. Our justification by faith makes us heirs to the most valuable possession of all; eternal life. (Romans 6:23)
- C. Our call to do good works. (v. 8)
 - 1. One of the reasons we are "born again" is to glorify God through good works. (John 15:5
 - **D.** Conclusion
 - 1. Remind yourself daily to devote yourself to good works.
