SERMON NOTE

June 16, 2024 VBS Sermon 2024

Romans 12:1-2

A LIVING SACRIFICE (Romans 12:1)

- *Paul uses the words urge and present with authority.
- *This statement shocks these believers who are familiar with presenting dead animals to please God and to be in a right relationship with God.

 we know that Jesus became the once-and-for-all

we know that Jesus became the once-and-for-all sacrificial lamb. (Hebrews 7:27)

- *The gospel call is that we, as his followers, surrender our lives or present our whole selves-mind, body, and spirit-to God for his purposes. (Mark 12:30)
- *We are now a "living sacrifice" to God, called to walk in the ways of Jesus Christ, and by doing so we become more like him. (Ephesians 2:1-3)
- *We will begin to experience a transformation in our lives.

NOT CONFORMED, BUT TRANSFORMED (Romans12:2)

- *Paul's statement is a command to obey and a reminder of the ongoing battle of the believer.
- *Satan's strategy is to get us to conform to the world's way of thinking and living.
- *The word conformed refers to an outward expression that doesn't necessarily reflect what is truly within us.
- *The word transformed speaks of freedom. It carries the idea of metamorphosis. (2 Corinthians 3:18)
- *The transformed and renewed mind is a mind that is saturated by God's Word so that we recognize error and stand for truth.
