SERMON NOTES

How Do We Treat Jesus?

1 Samuel 16 & 17

“We often treat Jesus the way Saul treated David. We want him to slay giants and sing evil spirits away, but we don’t want Him to be king.” A.W. Tozer

Background

- **Saul is Israel’s appointed king.**
- **David is God’s anointed king.**
- **David becomes a “means to an end for Saul.”**

Saul Sees God’s Anointing on David (1 Samuel 17:31-37; 1 Samuel 16:14-23)

- **The people’s appointed king is looking for others to fight for him.**
- **God’s anointed king is pushing people out of the way to get to the enemy.**
- **1 Samuel 16: The Spirit of God departs from Saul and “rushed upon David.”**

Saul Refuses God’s Will for Israel (1 Samuel 18:12)

- **Luke 6:46, Jn. 14:15, Matt. 7:21-23**
