Today at Pleasant Street - "Promises that Ripple: a service of water, word & witness".

What do a stone, a smooth pebble and a water strider (a small insect) have in common? They all make ripples on the water. The difference is that their size determines how far the ripples go. If you toss a stone high enough, it will send ripples throughout a pond.

Of all the symbols that God might've chosen to describe his promises to us and our Christian identity he chose water; the waters of Baptism. We want those promises to ripple out through every aspect of our lives, we want them to reverberate in the world around us.
