FINANCIAL UPDATE

Through July 2024, General Fund receipts totaled \$255,643. The General Fund budget requirement is \$299,089 leaving a deficit of \$(43,446). The actual deficit through July is \$(68,580). A couple of notes regarding this information include that the budget has been revised downward reflecting that we have not hired an Associate Pastor for 2024. We have also experienced large building expenses to mitigate water damage on two occasions to date this year. As we move into the last months of this year, the council asks that you prayerfully consider how you can continue to support the ministry of Pleasant St. CRC.

Updates on building projects: We are pleased to report that seat cushions in the sanctuary will be installed next week! One other project to be completed this fall is to upgrade our main entrance with a key fob entry system. This will lead to a significant improvement in securing our building. Further details on this project will be shared soon.
