## Key Points:

- Do not be unaware (ignorant) about spiritual gifts.
- There are many different gifts (approximately 24) but they all originate from the same Holy Spirit.
- Everyone receives at least one gift.
- You don't get to choose your gift; it is decided by the Holy Spirit.
- The gifts function like the body with many members.
- We are interdependent and need one another.
- Some gifts are more visible and noticeable than others, yet all are vital and necessary for good health.
- Gifts should not cause division, and we should not be jealous of others regarding gifts.
