

### Scripture Devotional

Advent – Christmas

Advent is the season when Christians observe a time of watchful waiting and preparation for Christ's coming. Over the centuries there have been different emphases, but there are really three preparations:

- i) for Jesus' coming at the end of time to judge the world
- ii) for the celebration of his birth in Bethlehem 2,000 years ago
- iii) for the arrival of Jesus in the heart of each believer.

The following readings are of longstanding use among Christians during Advent. The Lord's Prayer and a prayer for both the Advent and Christmas seasons are included as well.

### The Lord's Prayer

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. *Amen*.

### Prayer for the Advent Season

Almighty God, give us grace to cast away the works of darkness, and put on the armor of light, now in the time of this mortal life in which your Son Jesus Christ came to visit us in great humility; that in the last day, when he shall come again in his glorious majesty to judge both the living and the dead, we may rise to the life immortal; through him who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. *Amen*.
