Three Deportations

• 609 BC Daniel and the elites are deported to Babylon.

• 596 BC Ezekiel and a second wave – not to the city of Babylon.

• 587 BC Destruction of Jerusalem – Babylonian Captivity begins.

- Daniel Interprets
- King stricken with mental derangement for 7 years.
- The King recovers and publishes his testimony.

Chapter 5 – Fall of Babylon

- The handwriting on the wall.
- Persian conquest without a battle
- Daniel interprets Numbered, Weighed, Broken

Chapter 7 – The Four Beasts. (Empires)

- Babylon Nebuchadnezzar
- Persia Cyrus
- Greece Alexander (Four Generals)
- Rome began in 68 BC ends 476 AD breaks into pieces.

Chapter 8 – Ram and the Goat and the Little Horn

- Alexander defeats the Persians.
- Alexander dies and his kingdom is divided into four segments:
 - Cassander
 - o Lysimachus
 - o Ptolemy south in Egypt
 - o Seleucus North and West Syria to India
- The Little Horn is Antiochus Epiphanes a type of Antichrist.

Daniel 9 – The 70 Weeks – Key to understanding the End Times – See Matthew 24:15-16

- 70 Week are Determined for your people (Jewish, not church, not gentile)
- Six major items are listed:
 - o Finish transgression.
 - o End sin.
 - o Reconcile iniquity.
 - o Establish everlasting righteousness.
 - Seal up the vision and prophecy.
 - Anoint the Most Holy Place.
- 69 Weeks command to rebuild city and the temple:

o Cyrus 537 Ezra 1:2-4	Tempe only
------------------------	------------

o Darius Ezra 6:1-5,8,12 Temple only

o Artaxerxes Ezra 7: 11:26 Temple only

o Artaxerxes Nehemiah 2:5-8; 17,18 Temple and City!

- 173,880 Days
 - o May 14, 445 BC to April 6, 32 AD 173,880 Days
 - o Palm Sunday, Luke 19 Triumphal Entry

- Psalm 118:26 Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord, Hosannah in the highest.
- o Zechariah 9:9 fulfilled.
- o The Judgment Luke 19: 41-44
- The Interval Daniel 9:26
 - Messiah *Karat* cut off/executed.
 - The prince who will come historically the Romans who destroyed the temple in 70 AD.
- The 70th Week
 - o 7-year period
 - o 3 ½ midpoint major change
 - o The Great Tribulation Jacob's Troubles, Day of the Lord, Revelation 6 -19.
 - O Daniel 12:1 Michael stands up for his people, trouble like never before, names in the book.

Chapters 11 and 12 – Time Between the Testaments

- Kings of Seleucid and Ptolemaic Dynasties
- Antiochus Epiphanes type of Antichrist in OT
 - o 175 164 BC Syrian King
 - o Magnified himself as God.
 - o Tried to eradicate Jewish religion.
 - No circumcision (baptism)
 - No Sabbath
 - o Illegal to own the Torah.
 - o Forces sacrifice to pagan idols.
 - o Sacrificed a swine on the altar.
 - o Place idol to Zeus in the Holies of Holies.
 - o The Maccabean revolt began victory 3 years later.
 - o Rededicated the temple Hanukkah feast of lights.
