Examination

Then the Celebrant asks,

Will you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Lord and Savior? I will, with God's help.

As none can do this without God's grace, found in Word and Sacrament, will you join with us in our common life of worship, teaching, service, and fellowship? I will.

enrollment and exorcism

The Celebrant leads them to the chancel steps, where they kneel, and the Celebrant prays over them, saying,

Let us pray.

O Lord God of hosts, before the terrors of whose presence the armies of Hell are put to flight: Deliver *these* your *servants* from the powers of the world, the flesh, and the Devil; cast out from *them* every evil and unclean spirit that lurks in the heart, and any spirit of error or wickedness; and make them ready to receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

The Celebrant then makes the sign of the Cross upon the forehead of each one (and may use the Oil of Catechumens to do so), saying to each,

Almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness and evil and lead you into the light and obedience of the kingdom of his Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

the blessing

The Catchumens all kneeling, the Celebrant then blesses them, saying,

Almighty God, who in his love for you has called you to the knowledge of his grace, grant you an entrance into his kingdom; through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

Sponsors accompany Catechumens to seats among the people. The service continues with the Sermon and Nicene Creed.
