INTRODUCTION

Gahima Parish is one of the parishes of the Anglican Church of Rwanda Kibungo Diocese and it is made of 4 sub-parishes with 4800 Christians in total. It is located in the rural area surrounding the Kibungo town. Children from families of Gahima Parish are challenged by the lack of Nursery and Primary Schools where their children can get quality education.

For helping these children, the Church welcomed them from surrounding families and tried to care for them and give them pre-education using the old Church of the Parish. The old Church was divided in three rooms using Triplexes to accommodate three levels of Nursery (Baby class, Middle class & Top class). These three classrooms accommodate 182 children who are now in holidays.
