PRAYER OF LOOSING (said by all)

Father, I choose as an act of my will to loose any darkness from my soul: Any fear, any hate, any offense, any anger or sadness, any lust or perversion, any witchcraft, any frustration, any trauma or abuse from the past, anything that my eyes have seen that they shouldn't have seen, any lies I've believed—anything of the enemy that's in me, no matter how it got there. Father, I repent if I brought it in; But, however it got in there, I command it to be loosed right now in Jesus' name. I will be free from any addictions, any soul ties—it's all going right now!

After a time of silence, the priest pronounces the forgiveness of sins:

Almighty God, our heavenly Father, who in his great mercy has promised forgiveness of sins to all those who sincerely repent and with true faith turn to him, have mercy upon you, pardon and deliver you from all your sins, confirm and strengthen you in all goodness, and bring you to everlasting life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

PRAYER OF BINDING (said by all)

Father, I choose right now as an act of my will and as your child, to call back any parts of myself, my soul, that I gave away to anything that wasn't you; right now I call it back in Jesus' name.

Father, because I chose to loose the darkness and call back that part of myself that I gave away; right now I'm going to choose for you to download your life, your love, your joy, your words, your passion, your plans for my life into my soul; I bind to my soul your celebration, your expectations and your validation of my life. Right now I receive them and I bind those to my soul in Jesus' name.
