John Chapter 17 Teaching Notes

The Lord's Prayer (John 17) vs. The Disciples Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13)

Why can't Jesus prayer the prayer in Matthew 6 (the Disciples Prayer)?

John 17 has Three Sections

- 1. He prays for Himself (vs 1-5)
- 2. He prays for His current disciples (the 11 of course plus all others) -(vs 6-19)
- 3. He prays for us not yet born those who will believe in Him. (vs. 20-26)

Jesus' Prayer for Himself – vs. 1-5

- 1. The glorification of the Son
- 2. Power over all flesh
- 3. Eternal life through Him
 - a. Over angles and authorities (1 Pet 3:22)
 - b. All power in heaven and earth (Matt 28:18)
 - c. Over principalities and powers (Col 2: 10)
- 4. They we would know:
 - a. The one TRUE GOD
 - b. Jesus is the Messiah that the one true God (the Father) has sent
- 5. I have finished the work you sent me and have glorified the Father
 - a. We cannot add anything to what Jesus has already done for us.
- 6. I would have the glory I had with you before the world began

The Work of Jesus manifested the message of Jesus

•	Hebrews 10:7	I have come to do your will
•	Luke 2:49	I must be about my Fathers business
•	John 4: 34	My meat is to do the will of Him who sent me
•	John 19:30	It is finished <i>(tetelestai)</i> – paid in full
•	Daniel 9:24	Defines His work

Seventy's evens are decreed for your people and your holy city

- 1. to finish transgression,
- 2. to put an end to sin,
- 3. to atone for wickedness,
- 4. to bring in everlasting righteousness,
- 5. to seal up vision and prophecy and
- 6. to anoint the Most Holy Place.

Jesus' Prayer for the Disciples (other followers living at that time) Vs 6-19

- 1. Our Security
- 2. Our Deliverance
- 3. Our Sanctification
- 4. Our Unity
- 5. Our Union with Christ and the Father
- VS 6 I have manifested your name to them, and they have kept your word.
- Vs 7 Now they know my message and ministry come from the Father
- Vs 8 They have received your words and believed your words and believe you sent Me
- Vs 9 I do not pray for the world, but for those who believe in me.
 - o Jesus prayed for His enemies on the cross
 - o It is now our duty to prayer for the world (1 Tim 2:1-4)
- Vs 10 We belong to the Father and to the Son and Jesus is glorified by us.
- Vs 11 I am no longer in the World, we are in the world Father protect them (**security**); our security is

based on the Father name; and we are to be one (united with God); just as Jesus is one with God

- Vs. 12 I kept them while I was here, none were lost except Judas, the son of perdition
- Vs. 13 I am coming home to you my Father, give them my joy
- Vs. 14 The world's hatred of Me will be experienced by them also because we are NOT of the World.
 - Adam was from the earth; Jesus is from heaven I Cor 15:47)
 - We are to separate from sinners (Heb 7:26)
 - We are new creations in Jesus (II Cor. 5:17)
 - We are partaking of a heavenly calling (Heb 3:2)
 - Our citizenship is in heaven (Phil 3:20)
 - We have a heavenly inheritance (I Pet 1:3-5)
- Vs. 15 We are not to be taken out of the world so keep us from the evil one (**Deliverance**)
 - Three people in scripture asked to be taken out of the world:
 - o Moses
 - o Elijah
 - o Jonah
 - God receives more glory if we remain and bear witness to the world.
- Vs. 16 They are not of the world even as I am not of the world.

- We are in Christ, not Adam
- We are in the Spirit, not the flesh
- We have a different master Jesus, not Satan
- We have a different purpose glorify God, not ourselves
- We have a different citizenship
- Vs. 17 Sanctify us in the truth of God's eternal Word (Sanctification)
- Vs. 18 As you sent Me Send them Power of the Holy Spirit
- Vs. 19 Jesus sanctifies Himself so that we might be sanctified in the truth

Jesus' Prayer for Future Believers vs 20-26

- Vs. 20 For those who will believe through their word (my Word)
- Vs. 21 That we might:
 - 1. Be one, just as we are one (eternal unity of the Father and the Son)
 - 2. That the world may believe that you (the Father) has sent Me (the Son)
- Vs. 22 The glory you have given me, I give to them, that they may be one.
- Vs. 23 God the Father and God the Son and God the Holy Spirit all indwell us and love us.
- Vs. 24 That we would be with Jesus and behold His glory as it was before the foundation of the world
- Vs. 25 The world does not know the Father, Jesus does and so do we.
- Vs. 26 Jesus has declared to us the Father, may God's love be in us, just as it was in Jesus.
