## The Resurrection of Jesus

#### Last Week of Jesus' Life

Friday Jesus is at Bethany
Saturday The Triumphal Entry
Sunday Jesus curses the fig tree

Monday Conspirators counsel to betray and kill Jesus
 Tuesday Last Supper (14<sup>th</sup> of Nissan) – Exodus 12

• Wednesday Crucifixion

• Thursday Feast of Unleavened Bread begins

• Friday Women prepare spices

• Saturday Sabbath rest

• Sunday Resurrection (17<sup>th</sup> Nissan) – Note Genesis 8:4 – new beginning in Christ = Noah and new beginning for the earth.

Paul's explanation of the Gospel (good news) - I Corinthian's 15:1-4

- 1. Died for our sins according to the scriptures Isaiah 53
- 2. Was buried Isaiah 53:9
- 3. And He rose again on the third day according to the scriptures Ps 16:10; Ps 49:15

The third day – Matthew 12:24 – reference to Jonah

No resurrection our faith in in vain – I Cor. 15:13-19

## John Stott - Four Evidences of the Resurrection

- 1. The empty tomb no body was found
- 2. The post resurrection appearances
  - 1) To Mary Magdalene Jn 20:11-18; Mk 16:9-11
  - 2) To women returning from tomb Mt 28:8-10
  - 3) On Emmaus Road Mk 16:12; Lk 24:13-35
  - 4) To Peter 1 Cor 15:5
  - 5) To 10 disciples in Jerusalem Jn 20:19-25; Lk 24;36-49; Acts 1:3-5
  - 6) To 11 disciples in upper room Jn 20:26-31; 1 Cor 15:5
  - 7) To 7 disciples in Galilee Jn 21:1-25
  - 8) To apostles and >500 Mt 28:16-20; 1 Cor 15:6
  - 9) To James 1 Cor 15:7
  - 10) To apostles on Mt. Olives Acts 1:6-12; 1 Cor 15:7
  - 11) To Stephen at his stoning Acts 7:55-60
  - 12) To Paul at his conversion Acts 9:3-8, 17; 22:6-15; 26:12-19; 1 Cor 9:1; 15:8
  - 13) To Paul at Corinth Acts 18:9,10

- 14) To Paul in the temple Acts 22:17-21
- 15) To Paul later in Jerusalem Acts 23:11
- 16) To Paul in another vision 2 Cor 12:1-4
- 17) To John on Patmos Revelation
- 3. The Disciples were changed believed unto death
- 4. The Church the gates of hell have not prevailed against us

Also referenced in Job 19: 25 - 27 - I know my redeemer will live...

Also, it is interesting to note, it was Jesus' enemies that believed the tomb would be empty.

Vs 1-10 Mary Magdalene visits the tomb – discovers the stone is rolled away

- Healed by Jesus of 7 demons
- Was wealthy
- Was a leader of women
- Was a follower of Jesus from Galilee
- Watched the crucifixion
- Was at the cross with the others
- Went to tomb with spices for burial
- First to see the risen Lord
- Told the disciples

Peter and John run to see the empty tomb

- Find the linen clothes and the face cloth folded up
- They did not remember or know the scripture about Jesus being raised from the dead Ps 16:10; which is also quoted by Peter on the day of Pentecost in Acts 2:27
- They returned home.

### Vs 11 - 17

- Mary weeps and discovers two angels in the tomb
- See's Jesus but does not recognize Him thinks He's the gardener
- Recognizes Jesus when he calls her name
- Rabboni
- Stop clinging to me and go tell the others do not detail me I have something I need to do

Road to Emmaus – Luke 24:13-39

Vs 39 Flesh and bones – where is His blood?

# John 20: 19-23

- Door shut
- Jesus appears peace be with you (twice)
- Shows them His hands and His side
- As Father sent Mw, I am sending you in power of Holy Spirit
- Receive the Holy Spirit breathed on them note Genesis 2:7
- Forgiveness of sins only through Christ and the Gospel

# Vs 24 - 29 - Thomas

- Thomas was not present
- 8 days later
- Thomas believes
- Blessed are those who believe and yet have not seen (faith)

Vs 30 -31 – ... so that you might believe and have life in His name...
