

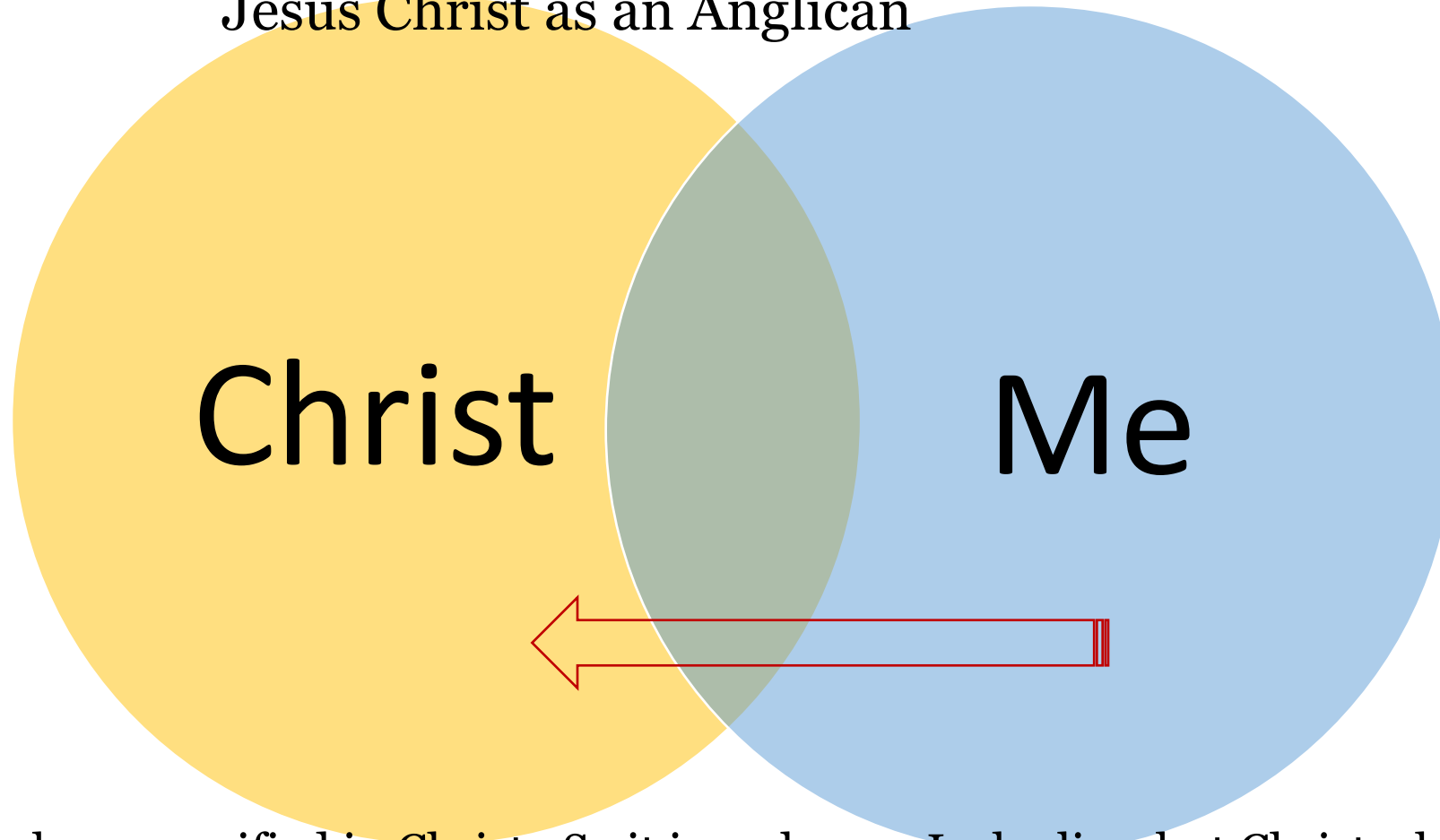
## Anglican Catechism for Mature Christians

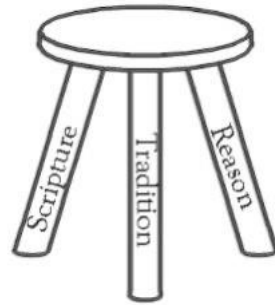
