- People received him
- Had a distinct dialect Matthew 26:73
- First miracle in John's Gospel wedding feast in Galilee
- Jesus met his disciples at sea of Galilee after the resurrection
- Pharisees debate if the Christ comes from Galilee (John 7:40-43. 52)

## 20. Rejected by His Own People

Isaiah 53:3 – we did not esteem Him

## Rejection of Jesus by Pharisees

- They conspired among themselves to destroy Him (Matt 12:14 withered hand healed on sabbath)
- They sought to kill Him (John 11 raising of Lazarus)
- Seven Woes Jesus Spoke regarding the Pharisees (Matthew 23)
- Caiaphas prophecies Jesus Death (John 11:53)
- John 1:11 He came to His own and they did not receive Him
- Luke 23:18 Away with Him, we want Barabbas

#### 21. Priest after Melchizedek

### Psalm 110:4 – A priest forever as Melchizedek

**Fulfilled Hebrews 5:5-6** 

#### Melchizedek

- King of Salem
- Priest of God
- Received tithe from Abraham (Gen 14:18-20
- King of Righteousness (Heb 7:2)
- Without Parentage (Heb 7:3)

#### Related to Christ

- A Priest
- Eternal
- A King

## 22. Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem

### **Zechariah 9:9 – King on a Donkey**

Fulfilled Luke 19:28-44; Mark 11:7, 9, 11

### Triumphal Entry

- Daniel 7:25 timeline 173,880 days Sir Robert Anderson Palm Sunday
- Psalm 118: 19-29 "blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord"
- Hallel Psalms 113-118 traditionally read/sung at Passover and other holidays
- Psalm 118 is very Messianic and singing it as Jesus entered Jerusalem was identifying Him as the Messiah and therefore was challenged by the Pharisees.
- Mark 11:7, 9, 11 the triumphal entry
- Luke 19: 28-44 Luke's version
