- **Talebearing** Prov 18:8
 - Destroys friendships
 - Kindles fires
 - Abounds in hearsay
- **Lying** Prov 12:17-22
 - o God hates it
 - o Its deceitful
 - o Will be punished
 - o Will be judged eternally (Rev 22:15)
- Talking Too Much Prov 18:6-7
 - o Too many words lead to sin
 - Leads to poverty and foolishness
 - o Few words are normally better listen more speak less
- Talking Too Soon Prov 18:13, 17
 - o Be slow to speak; quick to listen
 - o Restrained lips are wise
 - o Godly people study an answer fools just respond
- Flattery

- o Insincere praise with false motives
- o Works ruin
- o Is a form of lying
- o Kisses of an enemy are cruel
- o Can cause people to be proud, puffed up, conceited
- Quarreling Prov 26:28
 - o Causes unrighteous anger

 - Lack of self-control
