Chapter 30 – The Words of Agur – means "to collect"

VS 1-4 Agur makes a disclaimer – not the brightest, nor most learned, nor one who has vast knowledge of the Holy One.

Four questions

- 1. Who has ascended into heaven and descended?
- 2. Who has gathered the wind in His fists?
- 3. Who has wrapped the waters in a garment?
- 4. Who has established the ends of the earth?

Agur is referring to the Lord God – Jesus ascended and descended and is Lord over all creation – earth, air, wind, fire, and He (Jesus) established the earth. (John 1:1-3)

VS 5-6 – God's Word

- Tested
- A Shield
- A refuge
- Do not add to or take away from God's word. (Revelation 22:18)
- Psalm 119:97-104

VS 7-9 Two Things

- 1. Keep deception and lies from me
- 2. Give me neither poverty nor riches

VS 10 - 14 – Four kinds of people/generation

- 1. Who curses parents Exodus 20:12
- 2. Pure in their own eyes yet unclean Rev 3:17
- 3. Haughty and lofty with arrogance Proverbs 6:16-19
- 4. Ones who devour the needy and afflicted I Peter 5:8

VS 15 - 16 Four things that are never satisfied

- 1. The grave
- 2. The barren womb
- 3. Earth satisfied with water
- 4. Fire

VS 17 – mocking parents is punished

VS 18-19 Four Things I Do not Understand

- 1. Eagle in the sky
- 2. Serpent on the rock
- 3. Ship on the sea
- 4. A man with a maid

VS 20 – The Adulterous Woman

VS 21-23 – Four difficult things

- 1. A slave who becomes king
- 2. A fool who is full
- 3. Unloved woman who is married
- 4. A maid servant who supplants her mistress

VS 24-28 Four small things on the earth that are wise

- 1. Ants
- 2. Badgers
- 3. Locusts
- 4. Lizard

VS 29-31 Four things that are stately

- 1. Lion
- 2. Strutting cock
- 3. Male goat
- 4. King with his army
